

First Adult Passport (if the applicant is over 18 and was 16 or above at the time their current passport was issued)

This passport is valid for 10 years.

With regards to this case, the applicant may fill the renewal form online on www.passports.gov.au, however, they will need to print and present it at the Embassy **in person**.

Alternatively, if they choose not to fill the application online, we can provide an application at the time of the interview, which they will need to complete.

The required documents for a first adult passport are:

1. Your current passport (or has expired within the last 24 months and shows your current personal details).
2. Completed PC7 Renewal form (on case by case basis. An application can be filled at the Embassy).
3. Two colour photographs, no older than 6 months, as per Australian passport photograph guidelines (see notes below).

General Notes:

There is a photo studio located in the basement of the same complex as the Embassy, which is aware of our passport photo requirements. However, please note that they do not open before 10.00 am.

Australian Passport Photo Guidelines:

- 35 - 40mm wide and 45 - 50 mm high (Photograph Dimensions)
- **Head Size** : from the crown to chin (Min 32mm - Max 36mm)
- Good quality colour on high quality paper, with no ink or marks on the image
- Plain, light-coloured background (e.g. Cream or pale blue)
- Appropriate brightness and contrast and show your skin tones naturally
- Uniform lighting (no shadows across or behind the face), sharp focus and clear.
