## Child Passport Requirements (Under 16 – First Time Applications and Renewal)

The child does not need to attend in person.

- A completed PC8 form (with section 11 completed by a guarantor). The guarantor
  must possess an Australian passport or be an Australian or non-Australian currently
  employed in an approved professional or occupational group. You may fill the
  application online (www.passports.gov.au) or you can obtain a form through the
  Embassy.
- 2. Child / Parents' original passports.
- 3. Original birth certificate. (translated into English and authenticated by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs in Kuwait if done with Kuwaiti Translation Service)
- 4. Original Australian citizenship certificate, if applicable.
- 5. Original document that proves one of the parents' family names at birth (for example passport, marriage certificate or birth certificate).
- 6. Name change documents for parents or child if applicable (see notes on page 2-3).
- 7. Two colour photographs, no older than 6 months, as per the Australian passport photograph guidelines (see notes below). One photo must be signed as a true photo of the child by the guarantor (see notes on page 4)

## **General Notes:**

## **Australian Passport Photo Guidelines:**

- 35 40mm wide and 45 50 mm high (Photograph Dimensions)
- Head Size: from the crown to chin (Min 32mm Max 36mm)
- Good quality colour on high quality paper, with no ink or marks on the image
- Plain, light-coloured background (e.g. Cream or pale blue)
- Appropriate brightness and contrast and show your skin tones naturally
- Uniform lighting (no shadows across or behind the face), sharp focus and clear.
